\bigcirc	Organise tenancy agreement (this is required as proof of address for setting up things like bank accounts)	
\bigcirc	If property is unfurnished, find essential furniture company to get the basics for you ahead of the move

\bigcirc	Find school/nursery placements for your children?	
\bigcirc	International health insurance to cover the family	
\bigcirc	Check arrangements to bring pets (you may need special pet permits to bring cats and dogs into the country)	
\bigcirc	Arrange for appropriate vaccinations well in advance of going

\bigcirc	Visas/work permit for you and the family (apply at least 6 weeks before other preparations)
